



"IT WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT AN EXCEPTIONAL CONCERT WILL TAKE PLACE AT LONDON'S ROYAL ALBERT HALL ON MONDAY 15 SEPTEMBER 1997. THE ALL-STAR EVENT, ORGANISED BY SIR GEORGE AND LADY MARTIN TOGETHER WITH HARVEY GOLDSMITH WILL RAISE FUNDS FOR THE VICTIMS OF THE SOUFRIERE VOLCANO ON THE ISLAND OF MONTSERRAT WHICH HAS BEEN IN A CONTINUOUS STATE OF ERUPTION SINCE JULY 1995, THE MOST RECENT EXPLOSION IN JUNE 1997 KILLED 19 PEOPLE AND REN-DERED A FURTHER 1500 HOMELESS - TWO THIRDS OF THE ISLAND IS NOW IN THE DANGER ZONE. THE ARTISTS SO FAR CONFIRMED TO APPEAR AT THE CON-CERT REPRESENT A ROCK HALL OF FAME AND THEY ARE: ERIC CLAPTON, ELTON JOHN, MARK KNOPFLER, PAUL MCCARTNEY AND STING.

ALL MONIES RAISED WILL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE MONTSERRAT FOUNDATION AND WILL GO TO RELIEVE THE DISTRESS OF THE HOMELESS, THE SICK, THE AGED AND THE YOUNG OF MONTSERRAT.

"BUFFETT HAS RECORDED TWENTY NINE ALBUMS, INCLUDING SIX GOLD, THREE PLATINUM AND TWO MULTI-PLATINUM RELEASES. HIS RECORDING OF BOATS, BEACHES, BARS & BALLADS IS THE BIGGEST SELLING BOX SET IN MCA RECORDS HISTORY. JIMMY WAS ONE OF THE FIRST ARTISTS TO RECORD AT AIR STUDIOS MONTSERRAT AND THE RESULTING ALBUM ENTITLED VOLCANO HAS SOLD OVER 700,000 COPIES AND THE SINGLE OF THE SAME NAME IS A FAVORITE AT JIMMY'S SHOWS."

"FRIDAY WAS THE SOUND CHECK, WHICH WAS ALMOST AS GOOD AS THE ACTUAL CONCERT. ERIC CLAPTON WAS COOL. HE PLAYS THE ROYAL ALBERT HALL QUITE OFTEN AND LOOKS AS IF HE'S VERY COMFORTABLE THERE. JIMMY HAD LUNCH WITH ISLAND RECORD OWNER CHRIS BLACKWELL WHILE RALPH, ROBERT AND I TOOK OFF. RALPH DIDN'T WANT TO SIGHTSEE, HE'D BEEN TO LONDON SEVERAL TIMES. JIMMY RENEWED OLD ACQUAINTANCES WITH STING AND ERIC CLAPTON, AND SPENT NEARLY AN HOUR TALKING WITH PAUL MCCARTNEY AND HIS SON. THE OTHER ARTISTS TOUR THE U.S. FREQUENTLY,

AND ARE TOUR CONSCIOUS; THEY KNOW HOW SUCCESSFUL A BUFFETT TOUR IS, AND ARE OBVIOUSLY CURIOUS. IMAGINE JIMMY TRYING TO EXPLAIN PARROT HEADS TO ELTON JOHN.

have often been asked why I chose Montserrat as a location for a sophisticated modern recording studio. The answer was simple. I fell in love with the place and the people. When my wife and I first visited the island in 1977 we found a beautiful land with a genuine feeling of peace and amity, and I knew that it had the right ambience for the creation of good music.

For nearly eleven years Air Studios helped to shape the sounds of the world's finest recording artists, and all Montserratians were proud that their island was host to many famous stars. Sadly it ended with Hurricane Hugo, which brought the island to its knees. It was then that I first saw for myself the islanders' courage in the face of disaster. They braced themselves and started all over again.

And now, cruelly, for two years they have had to bear a cycle of volcanic eruptions which has robbed them of their main town and seaport, their airport, much of their industry and the best of their agricultural land. Thousands have lost everything; their homes and livelihoods, and some their lives. It seems the world judges Montserrat to be finished. Many Montserratians believe otherwise, and hope that a new future can be built in the safer northern part of the country.

It is a measure of their regard for the people of Montserrat that the response to my appeal by the stars who recorded there was both immediate and positive. I would like to thank each and every one of them - and the countless number of people who have made this concert possible - for their generosity in giving so freely of their time and effort. Not one person hesitated, and so tonight we are sending everyone a message. We give our sympathy, encouragement, firm support and our love to a brave little island.

Don't Stop The Carnival

The Carbonell Awards are given by the South Florida Critics' Association to salute the best work of local theaters. The awards are named after Miami sculptor Manuel Carbonell, who created and donates the solid bronze statuettes for the program. Jimmy Buffett and Herman Wouk's colaboration on Don't Stop the Carnival received 14 nominations for the 1996 -1997 theater season.

According to Christine Dolen, Miami Herald Theater Critic, "It is the runaway leader among shows vying for the 22nd annual Carbonell Awards. Nominated as best musical and best new work, Don't Stop the Carnival also snagged nominations for key performers Michael Rupert, Josh Mostel, Avery Sommers, Sandy Edgerton, Susan Dawn Carson and Aaron Cimadevilla, as well as director-choreographer David Bell."

Don't Stop the Carnival is Pulitzer Prized winning author Herman Wouk's now classic story of a middle-aged New Yorker seeking the simple life running a hotel on a Caribbean island. Jimmy and Herman Wouk continue to labor over the musical, creatively fine tuning the piece for an anticipated New York City performance.
